The institution was founded in 1833, being one of the oldest schools in Dâmbovița County.

The school is named after Vasile Cîrlova, considered the first modern Romanian poet.

Why does he represent the school? He wrote "The Ruins of Târgoviște", the poem that transformed the city into a national symbol. He represents the beginnings of Romanian modernity (the period in which the school was also founded).

Extracurricular activities

- Christmas Market: Every year, we hold a charity event at school where we sell things we make ourselves. We set up stalls with handmade crafts and treats, and all the money we raise goes to help the people in need. It's my favorite tradition because we get to be creative for a good cause.





- Our National Flag March :
The Flag March is an event in which hundreds of students take and carry the 100-meter flag, transforming practically the entire city center into a huge river of colors that stretches for hundreds of meters. It is an impressive urban parade where participants synchronize perfectly to hold the giant Flag creating a spectacular visual moment in the city.

The school is not just local, it is international. They have mobility projects where the teachers and students go to countries like Spain, Greece or Italy to learn new teaching and learning methods.
